REQUIREMENTS FOR THE HONOR ROLL & HIGH HONOR ROLL

HONOR ROLL

At Mission Hills Middle School, to be on the **honor roll**, a student must have

- 1. An overall GPA of 3.5-3.89 on the report card, for the school year (B average).
- 2. No report card grade lower than a C- in any subject during the school year.
- 3. No more than 1 C in a main core subject per year.
- 4. No C's in the last trimester
- 5. Student should not have broken any academic school policy.

HIGH HONOR ROLL

To be on the **HIGH HONOR ROLL**, a student must have:

- 1. An overall GPA of 3.9-4.0 on the report card for the school year.
 - 2. No report card grade lower than a B- in any subject during the school year.
 - 3. No more than one B average in a subject per year.
 - 4. Student should not have broken any academic school policy.

What does it take to be a valedictorian?

To be named the valedictorian, a student must be on the high honor roll all through middle school and currently have the highest academic performance in the 8th grade.

But there is more to it than that.....

- It's not just about doing what you were asked to do, but sometimes taking control of the situation and doing what needs to be done.
- It's not about complaining over a task, but challenging yourself to do the best for any task.
- It's about always giving it %110, no matter how boring, how tiring, or how unnecessary a task may be.
