Mission Hills Middle School is happy to offer its 2025 Summer Camp to students grades Jr.K to 5th. Our Summer Camp will consist of weekly themes with projects, reading, fitness, and other age-appropriate indoor/outdoor activities incorporated into the weekly schedule. The students will be grouped by grade level, and the program will be run by MHMS teachers/staff.

The following are the details of the **five-week** MHMS Summer Camp:

Duration: June 23 - July 25, 2025 (no school on July 4, 2025 in observance of 4th of July)

Camp Hours: Monday - Friday, 9:00am - 3:00pm/with extended care: 8:30am - 5:00pm

Cost: **\$2,000** for 5 weeks or \$550 weekly

Snacks & Lunch: Students **must** bring their own snacks & lunches

Weekly Themes:

Week 1: Animal Safari Week (June 23rd - 27th)

Week 2: Culinary Chefs Week (June 30th - July 3rd)

Week 3: Magical Storybook Adventures Week (July 7th - July 11th)

Week 4: Space Explorers Week (July 14th - 18th)

Week 5: Engineering Explorers Week (July 21st - July 25th)

Payment Procedure for Registered MHMS Students:

- Registration for the 2025 Summer Camp is now open. *Space is limited - first come-first served.* If attending **all 5 weeks**, your **non-refundable** 1st payment of \$500 is due at time you submit the completed registration (this payment will count towards your first week). The remaining balance of \$1,500 is due by **Friday, May 30, 2025.**
- If you are attending **less than 5 weeks**, your **non-refundable** 1st payment of \$550 is due at the time you submit the completed registration (this payment will count towards your first week). The remaining balance is due by **Friday, May 30, 2025 (please email jnghiem@mhmschool.org for your total amount).**

- The last day to submit the completed registration form and the **non-refundable** payment to the MHMS administration is **Friday, May 30, 2025.**



MHMS Summer Camp Schedule


Monday - Friday June 23, 2025 - July 25, 2025


9:00am - 3:00pm with extended care: 8:30am - 5:00pm

MHMS Summer Camp includes:

 Math: Fun activities focused on number skills, problem solving, and mental math strategies.

 Logic: Engaging in activities to enhance critical thinking, puzzles, and problem-solving.

 English: Vocabulary building, grammar and reading comprehension

 Writing: Creative and structured writing exercises, including storytelling and essay writing.

Each week, children will explore a new theme through engaging activities, hands-on projects, outdoor play, and interactive storytelling. These camps are designed to spark curiosity, creativity, and learning in a fun and nurturing environment.

Week 1: Animal Safari Week (June 23rd - 27th)

Take a trip around the world to explore wild animals from different habitats! Children will learn about lions, giraffes, elephants, and zebras as they pretend to go on a safari. They will create animal masks, and play jungle-themed games. Through storytelling and interactive play, kids will learn fun facts about the animal kingdom while using their imagination.

Week 2: Culinary Chefs Week (June 30th - July 3rd)

Children will explore the joy of cooking and baking! They will learn simple recipes like making fruit salad, decorating cookies, and mixing dough. Through sensory play with flour and pretend cooking stations, they will develop math skills like counting and measuring. This encourages teamwork, following directions, and exploring new flavors in a fun and interactive way!

Week 3: Magical Storybook Adventures Week (July 7th - July 11th)

Step into a world of imagination as we bring classic fairy tales and favorite children's books to life! Each day, children will dive into a different story, acting out scenes, creating crafts, and engaging in themed sensory activities. From building the Three Little Pigs' houses to painting magical wands, kids will experience storytelling in a whole new way. This week encourages a love for reading while fostering creativity and self-expression

Week 4: Space Explorers Week (July 14th - 18th)

Blast off into a galaxy of fun! Students will learn about the planets, stars, and moon through engaging activities like making slime, designing their own rockets, and creating glow-in-the-dark constellations. They will also participate in a "moonwalk" obstacle course and pretend to be astronauts on a missions. This week encourages curiosity about space while introducing STEM concepts.

Week 5: Engineering Explorers Week (July 21st - July 25th)

Children will become young inventors as they explore the world of building, designing, and problem-solving. Using blocks, cardboard, and other materials, they will create simple structures like bridges, towers, and tunnels. They will also experiment with ramps, pulleys, and gears to see how things move. Through hands-on STEAM activities, kids will develop teamwork, creativity, and critical thinking skills in an exciting and interactive way!

Mission Hills Middle School Summer Camp Policies

Welcome to Mission Hills Middle School Summer Camp! Please review the following policies carefully:

1. Holidays:

- Independence Day: Friday, July 04, 2025

2. Registered MHMS students:

- Registration and Payment: Space is limited. Enrollment is first-come, first served. If attending all 5 weeks, your non-refundable 1st payment of \$500 is due at the time you submit the completed registration form (this payment will count towards your first week.) The remaining balance of \$1,500 is due by Friday, May 30, 2025.
- If you are attending less than 5 weeks, your non-refundable 1st payment of \$550 is due at the time you submit the completed registration form (this payment will count towards your first week). The remaining balance is due by Friday, May 30, 2025 (please email jnghiem@mhmschool.org for your total amount).

3. Non-Registered MHMS Students:

- Completed registration form must be accompanied by your non-refundable total payment at the time of registration submission.

4. Registration Deadline: The last day to submit the completed registration form and non-refundable payment is Friday, May 30, 2025.

5. Drop-off & Pick-Up: Drop-off starts at 8:30am; pick-up is no later than 5:00pm. Late fees will apply. Only authorized individuals may pick up a student. ID may be required.

6. Healthy & Safety: Sick children must stay home until symptom-free for 24 hours. Parents will be called for pick-up if illness occurs at camp. Allergies must be disclosed. MHMS cannot guarantee an allergen-free environment. Parents must provide medication with medical authorization form. In emergencies, 911 will be called immediately; parents are responsible for emergency medical costs.

7. Behavior & Conduct: Students must follow instructions and treat peers and staff with respect. Aggressive/disruptive behavior may result in removal with a refund. Bullying is not tolerated.

8. Meal & Snacks: Parents must provide a packed lunch and two snacks. **NO sodas, candy, or junk food.** Students must bring a labeled water bottle daily. Hot lunch is NOT available.

9. Attire & Personal Belongings: Students must wear comfortable clothing and closed-toe shoes. Sunscreen must be applied before arrival. Electronics, toys, and valuables are not allowed; MHMS is not responsible for lost items.

10. Field Trips & Outdoor Activities: Parents will receive advance notice of off-campus trips. Signed permission slips are required.

11. Inclement Weather & Emergencies: Outdoor activities may be moved indoors in extreme weather. Parents will be notified of any schedule changes. Emergency protocols, including shelter-in-place and evacuation, will be followed.

12. Communication & Updates: For urgent matters, contact the school office directly.
