Mission Hills School is happy to offer its *annual* Summer Camp to students in grades Jr. Kindergarten to 6th grade. The students will be grouped by grade level, and the program will be run by MHS teachers/staff. In the mornings, each class will do an academic review of the previous grade they just completed (they're not learning *new* material). Review helps the students retain information they have just learned in the school year and strengthens their skills.

In the afternoon students do arts/crafts and fun activities related to the weekly theme. For example: Jungle week crafts will be about the jungle and animals. The USA beach party theme is on the 4th of July in the USA. Happiest camp on earth is Disney related. Out of this world is space and science related. All Star Sports is pertaining to sports.

The following are the details of the five-week Summer Camp:

Duration: June 23—July 25, 2025 (no school on Friday, July 4, 2025 in observance of 4th of July)

Camp Hours: Monday- Friday, 9:00am-3:00pm / with extended care: 8:00am- 5:30pm

***Cost (Extended Care Included):**

REGISTERED MHS STUDENTS— \$1,875 for all 5 weeks OR \$400 weekly

NON-MHS STUDENTS— \$2,000 for all 5 weeks OR \$425 weekly

***payments accepted:** cash, check payable to Mission Hills School, Cashier's Check, or Money Order

Lunch: Students **must** bring their own lunches & snacks; the student snack store will be closed during the Summer

Weekly Themes (*Themes are subject to change):

Week 2: USA Beach Party Week (June 30 - July 3rd) *No school on Friday, July 4*

Week 3: Happiest Camp On Earth Week (July 7th-11th)

Week 5: All-Star Sports Week (July 21st - 25th)

Payment Procedure for Registered MHS Students:

- Registration for the 2025 Summer Camp is **now open**. *Space is limited—first come-first serve.*
 - If attending **all 5 weeks**, your **non-refundable** 1st payment of \$375 is due at the time you submit the completed registration. The remaining balance of \$1,500 is due by **Friday, May 30, 2025**
 - If you are attending **less than 5 weeks**, your **non-refundable** 1st payment of \$400 is due at the time you submit the completed registration (this payment will count towards your first week). The remaining balance is due by **Friday, May 30, 2025 (please ask for your total amount at the main office).**

Payment Procedure for Non-Registered MHS students:

- Registration for the 2025 Summer Camp is now open. *Space is limited—first come-first serve.*
 - The completed registration form must be accompanied by your **non-refundable full payment** at the time you submit the registration.
 - The last day to submit the completed registration form and the **non-refundable payment to the MHS administration is Friday, May 30, 2025.**

Camp Hours: 9am-3pm with **extended care** 8am-5:30pm

MHS Summer Camp Includes:

	<p>MATH: Fun activities focused on review material from the previous grade i.e. number skills, problem solving, and basic math operations.</p>
	<p>ENGLISH: Reading comprehension, fluency, grammar, and vocabulary building.</p>
	<p>LOGIC: Engaging in activities to enhance critical thinking, such as puzzles and problem-solving games.</p>
	<p>ARTS & CRAFTS: A wide range of creative activities, including painting, crafting, coloring, and making art by hand, to exercise students' imagination and self-expression.</p>

Based on the theme each week, children will participate in engaging activities, fun interactive projects, outdoor play, and partake in memorable school events. These camps are designed to offer academic review and enrichment while sparking creativity, curiosity, and enjoyment in a nurturing school environment.

Week 1 – Jungle Week (June 23 - 27): Join us in the jungle! Students will learn about a variety of animals ranging from exotic birds to tigers, jaguars, anacondas, and more! Children will create art projects and learn fun facts about the animal kingdom while using their imagination.

Week 2 – USA Beach Party Week (June 30 - July 3) *No school on Friday, July 4*: Students will celebrate America with a 4th of July school party including firecracker popsicles and pizza! They will engage in lots of USA-themed arts/crafts, activities, and use of jumbo bubble wands. They will have class discussions or circle time to discuss fun country facts, family 4th of July traditions, and more.

Week 3 – Happiest Camp On Earth Week (July 7 - 11): Step into a world of imagination as we bring Disney to MHS! Children will create crafts, sing Disney songs, rock their favorite Disney attire, and experience our on-site Petting Zoo. Kids will get to enjoy their love for Disney at summer camp!

Week 4– Out of This World Week (July 14 -18): 3..2..1..take off to MHS’ orbit of excitement. Students will learn about planets, stars, and the moon through slime making, rocket building, and collaborative STEM projects.

Week 5– All Star Sports Week (July 21 - 25): Welcome to Golden State Warriors Ground during our sports week! Students will participate in a field day extravaganza, including tug-a-war, obstacle course, inflatable jump house, etc. Students will engage in activities that encourage teamwork, resilience, and creativity all week long. Our last day will be celebrated by watching a kid-friendly movie and enjoying an ice cream party!

SPECIAL additions: We will welcome back our friendly buddy, Boswick the Clown, for a school-wide assembly! Students will also have Spanish and Physical Education electives to enjoy every week!

MHS Summer Camp Drop-Off and Pick-Up Procedures:

For ALL GRADES, morning drop-off (8:00-9:00 am) will be at the school gate door; parents will park their cars and walk their kids to the gate door. Parents will then ring the doorbell and Ms. Maria, Head of Supporting Staff, will be there to welcome the children into the school.

Afternoon pick-up **from 3:00pm-5:30pm for ALL grades** will be at the same gate door as morning drop-off. Parents must park, ring the doorbell, and enter through the gate to sign out their children via sign-out sheets.
